North Los Angeles County Youth Championship Rules

1. All eligible bowlers must be youth members of the North Los Angeles County USBC (NLAC) with a verified average in NLAC. Youth bowlers from outside associations must bowl a minimum of 3 league sessions certified within this association to be eligible; proof of certification must be submitted with paid entries.
2. Entries will be processed and scheduled in the order they are received by the NLAC Association Manager.
3. **Lineup:** Order cannot be changed from original entry form. Subs bowl in the position of original bowler.
4. Bowlers must check-in at least 45 minutes before scheduled squad time. Please bring USBC membership cards to check-in. All doubles and team members must check in together. Squads may start earlier, if everyone has checked in. All substitutions must be made thirty (30) minutes prior to scheduled squad time. Substitutes must show current USBC membership at check-in.
5. **Attire: Dress appropriately for a championship. No sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. NO tank tops, halter tops, sweats, spandex, "cut-off's" or short shorts of any kind allowed. Walking shorts, "skorts" and skirts are permitted. No head covering or sunglasses once competition begins. No electronic devices allowed in the bowler's area. Tournament Management must approve any/all exceptions prior to competition.**
6. **Entry fee:** \$25 per person/per event; **Team:** \$12 lineage + \$10 prize + \$3 expenses. **DS:** \$11.25 lineage + \$10.75 prize + \$3 expenses. **All-Events:** \$5 per person. Only approved refunds at the discretion of the Tournament Manager. Any returned checks must be paid in cash or money order prior to competition plus a \$50 penalty fee.
7. Trophies will be awarded at least one (1) for every ten (10) entries per division. Awards and Scholarship fees shall be returned 100% to the bowlers. Scholarships will be held with the USBC SMART program under account #10677, (800) 514-2695 x8292.
8. **Each event will be split equally into A & B Divisions. If the division split is 10 entries or less, both divisions will be combined into one.** Tournament Management reserves the right to cancel any squad with 10 or fewer entries.
9. If possible, additional squads may be added if all regular squads are filled prior to entry closing date. Squads may be cancelled if not needed.
10. **ENTERING AVERAGES:**
 - a. Highest USBC **2017-18** certified average (minimum 5 league sessions), if none,
 - b. Highest USBC certified **CURRENT** average as of the tournament date (must bring league sheet, min. 5 league sessions), if none,
 - c. Highest USBC **2016-17** certified average (minimum 5 league sessions), if none,
 - d. Enter at 210

Tournament Management has the right to adjust a bowler's entering average. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages. If a "sport" average is the bowler's only verifiable average, it should be marked with an "SP" in the average box on the Entry Form. That average will be adjusted per the USBC sport chart to determine the correct entering average.
11. **HANDICAP:** 100% of 210
12. No smoking/vaping during tournament play. Non-alcoholic drinks and food are permissible in the back area only.
13. Once a replacement has started an event, they must complete that event except in the case of an emergency.
14. **Team:** Any four (4) members. Team event may be bowled twice with at least two (2) different players changed in the line-up. No partial teams accepted. **Doubles/Singles:** Any two (2) bowlers. Averages determine divisions. D/S event may be bowled twice with at least one (1) member player changed in the doubles line-up. If a replacement enters Singles, they must also enter Doubles. The first appearance in each event counts towards All-Events. Re-entries are based on squad availability and bowlers may place only once in All-Events and Singles.
15. Competition will consist of three (3) games in each event.
16. In Team event, only one (1) bowling ball for each entrant allowed on the rack. In Doubles and Singles event, no more than two (2) bowling balls for each entrant allowed on the rack.
17. TARDY bowlers shall start in the frame currently being bowled. A zero (0) shall be scored for all missed frames. There shall be no BLIND scores or pacers.
18. Any person who bowls under an assumed name, under the name of another person scheduled to bowl in the tournament, or who is under suspension from USBC membership shall be disqualified and will forfeit any fees and awards. They will also be subject to suspension from USBC membership.
19. Observe one (1) lane courtesy only.
20. Altering the surface of a bowling ball by the use of abrasives while bowling in USBC competition is prohibited. All bowling balls so altered must be removed from the competition. (See the USBC Equipment Specifications Manual on BOWL.com.) The use of approved cleaning agents listed in the Approved Anytime section of the Approved Cleaners and Polishes list is permissible. If it is determined the bowler had prior knowledge that the actions were in violation of USBC Rule 18, the game(s) in which the violation occurred is subject to forfeiture and the bowler is subject to disqualification, loss of entry fee, and possible USBC suspension.
21. Action on the lanes, which is considered unsportsmanlike or disruptive, will not be tolerated. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of youth bowling in conjunction with USBC will result in immediate disqualification (Refer to rule 17D) and forfeiture of any fees and awards.
22. Claims of errors in score keeping must be filed with NLAC Association Manager in writing within seventy-two (72) hours of the time the error was made. Tournament Management shall settle all questions not covered by either the NLAC or the USBC Rule Book.
23. Designated scholarship will be paid accordingly to each division within 30 days upon completion of the tournament, except when USBC nationals has authorized delay in payment, pending settlement of any claim or protest which effects position standings.
24. Protests must be filed with Tournament Management in writing within 72 hours after the close of the tournament. All decisions made by Tournament Management are final. The penalty for violation of any portion of these rules shall be possible suspension from USBC. Such suspension shall remain in force until removed by the legal committee of the USBC.
