U17 DIVISION – BIRTHDATE IS 8/1/2001 THRU 7/31/03
U20 DIVISION – BIRTHDATE IS 8/1/1998 THRU 7/31/01

NLAC JUNIOR GOLD 5-GAMER TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress (Certification # _____) and shall be governed by USBC rules.
2. **Entry Fee:** \$55 per bowler (\$18.75 lineage + \$3.25 expenses + \$33 Gold/DW Challenge entry. Make checks or money orders payable to: **NLAC USBC**. Any returned checks must be paid in cash or money order prior to competition plus a \$50 penalty fee.
3. **Format:** Bowlers will bowl five (5) games scratch moving pairs after each game. Total scratch pinfall will determine the berth winner in the U20/U17 group and in the U15/U12 group. In case of a tie for the final qualifying position to the 2019 Junior Gold Championships, the highest game 5 score will be used to determine the final advancing bowler.
4. **Berths:** Junior Gold berths will be award based on a minimum ratio of 1:8 per division if sufficient entries exist. If the ratio is met in a division and additional funds are left over, the bowler with the next highest score has the option to fund ("make up") the difference and accept an additional spot. If "make up" funds are not received within 7 days, the additional funds will be divided equally among all remaining entrants in that division and submitted to SMART (Account #10677), (800) 514-2695 x8292.
5. All divisions must meet a minimum number of entrants to be conducted. If a division does not meet the minimum number of entrants, divisions may be combined at the Tournament Director's discretion. Should there be an insufficient number of entrants in any female division, the entrants must decide if they wish to bowl in the male division receive a full entry refund (or visa versa). If an entry winner withdraws their berth, replacements will be eligible based on the order of finish.
6. **DW Challenge Qualifier:** A minimum of 9 bowlers per division is needed. If less than 9 entries are received no entry will be awarded. The winner(s) will earn a free entry into the Diddy Watts Youth State Singles Challenge Qualifier to be held June 29-30, 2019 (Locations TBA) or the last chance qualifier on August 10, 2019 at McHenry Bowl, Modesto. If an entry winner withdraws their berth, replacements will be eligible based on the order of finish.
7. **Tournament attire please.** No sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. NO tank tops, halter tops, sweats, spandex, "cut-off's" or short shorts of any kind allowed. Walking shorts, "skorts" and skirts are permitted. No head covering or sunglasses once competition begins. No electronic devices allowed in the bowler's area. Tournament Management must approve any/all exceptions prior to competition.
8. Tardy bowlers shall start in the frame currently being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Frames may not be made-up. A bowler not present to bowl when it's their turn will be also credited with a zero for that frame.
9. Food and drinks are permissible in the back area only. Alcoholic beverages may NOT be consumed while participating in tournament. Adults consuming alcohol must remain in the lounge or in back concourse area. No tobacco or smoking products permitted by any participants. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of youth bowling in conjunction with USBC will result in immediate disqualification (Refer to rule 17D).
10. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the NLAC USBC, which also reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.
