2. League fees are \$20 per week per person (\$12 lineage + \$8 scholarship/awards fund). Lineage may vary per center. Any excess lineage will go towards scholarships/awards. No shortages allowed.

5. The following achievements will receive awards (male, female, boy & girl): High average, high handicap series & game, high scratch series & game, high average and most improved.
6. Scholarship fund shall be returned 100% to the bowlers. Scholarships will be awarded to the youth only and will be held with the USBC SMART program under account #10677, (800) 514-2695 x8292.
7. HANDICAP: 90% of 230
8. **FORMAT: Trios (minimum one youth per team) bowling three games on the same pair of lanes. Points to be earned for each game plus series.**
9. **No Pre-Bowls or Make-ups allowed.**
10. Blind scores will be the bowler's average minus 10 pins for wins and losses only. No pacers allowed.
11. One lane courtesy only.
12. Non-alcoholic drinks and food are permissible in the back area only. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of youth bowling in conjunction with USBC will result in immediate disqualification (USBC 17D).
13. Any use of abrasives, chemical, solvents or other methods to alter the surface of a bowling ball is prohibited after competition has begun. Any ball so altered must be removed from the competition, and if it is determined the bowler had prior knowledge that the actions were in violation of USBC Rule 18, the game(s) in which the violation occurred is subject to forfeiture and the bowler is subject to disqualification, loss of league fees, and possible suspension from USBC membership. **ONLY A DRY TOWEL MAY USED DURING LEAGUE.**
14. Action on the lanes, which is considered unsportsmanlike or disruptive, will not be tolerated. IMPROPER CONDUCT as determined by the tournament management may result in disqualification, will forfeit league fees and any prize/scholarship money.
15. All other league rules will be covered by the USBC Rule Book.
